Definitions:

Yard Stop A: Driver walks up driveway to retrieve carts-short driveway & standard truck

Yard Stop B: Driver walks up driveway to retrieve carts-long driveway & standard truck

Yard Stop C: Small, specialized 'mini' truck allows driver to traverse long, narrow, remote roads

Easement 1: Service on easement — driver can enter and turn truck around in easement

Easement 2: Service on easement — no turnaround; driver backs in

First Residential: Master HOA billing Account — first unit

Each Additional: Master HOA billing Account — each unit beyond the first

Rates* If approved at the public hearing, the City may impose automatic future inflationary adjustments pursuant to Government Code section 53756, for five years. If implemented, rates will be increased by the sum of: (1) the San Diego, CA area Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers (all items), base period of 1982 – 84 = 100, published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for the latest second half calendar year period for which statistics are available; and (2) an increase in landfill fees as set through the Regional Solid Waste Association (RSWA). Customers will receive advanced mailed notice of these future rate increases no more than 30 days in advance, as required under Government Code section 53756.
