



Gann Appropriations Limit

On May 26, 2026 the Vista City Council will establish by resolution, its appropriation limit, commonly referred to as the “GANN Limit”, for the upcoming fiscal year pursuant to Article XIII B of the California Constitution. Under the Gann Limit, a maximum amount is established for tax-funded government services. That amount is to be adjusted each year depending on changes in state population, inflation, and the transfer of financial responsibility for various government activities from one level of government to another. Any significant amount of state tax revenue received above that Gann Limit is to lead to future tax rebates or tax cuts.
